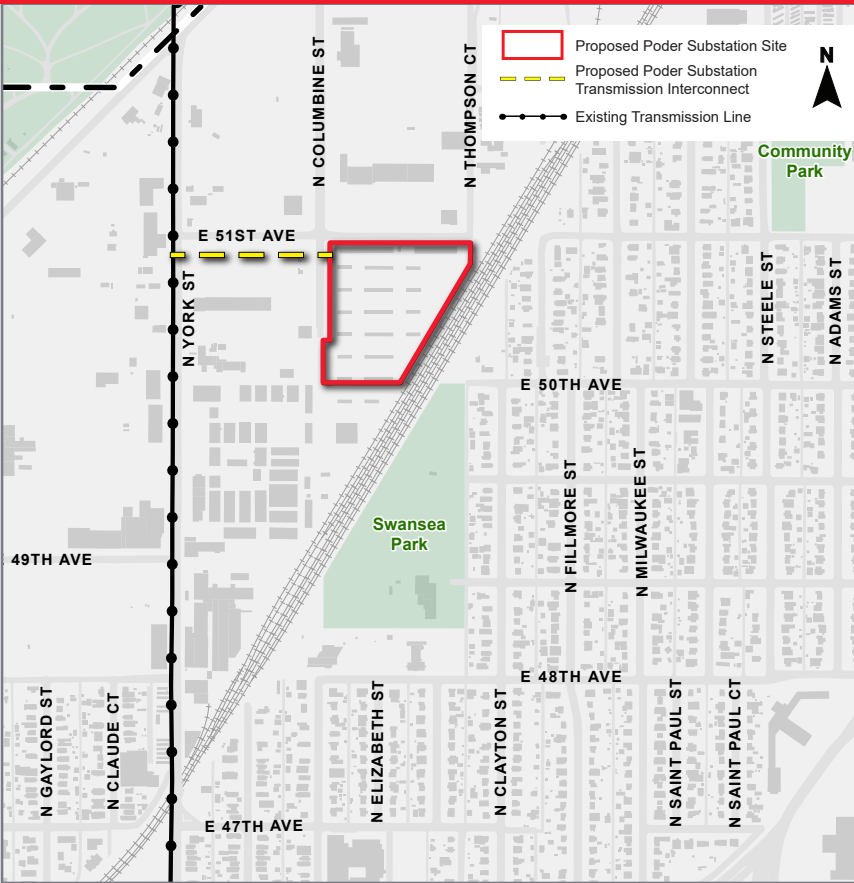
Overview

Poder Substation is a new electric substation to be located at East 51st Avenue and Columbine Street. The substation will be connected to the existing transmission line along York Street, one block to the west.

Xcel Energy is making upgrades to the electric system in this area to reliably serve the additional customer need anticipated for the future. Poder Substation will improve overall system reliability and resilience in the Elyria-Swansea, Globeville, Five Points and other neighborhoods, and backup existing substations that are reaching capacity.

Construction is expected to begin in 2024 and is anticipated to be completed in 2026, pending permit approvals.
